**THE GREAT CALIFORNIA SHAKEOUT
AND
LIFE SAFETY DRILL: EVACUATION**

- What:** The Great California Shakeout is conducted annually by the State of California's Emergency Preparedness Agency to assist public agencies in responding to an earthquake.
- When:** The Great Shakeout will occur Thursday, October 15, 2015 (10-15-2015) at 10:15 a.m.
- Who:** All Faculty, Staff, Students and Guests.
- How:** The Great Shakeout will consist of a Drop, Cover and Hold On drill that will last for two (2) minutes. After which, a Life Safety Drill, Evacuation, will be implemented whereby all buildings and classrooms will be evacuated to designated areas.

What Happens

1. At 10:15 a.m. an email announcement and Blackboard Connect alerts will be sent campus-wide denoting the start of the Drop, Cover, and Hold On exercise.
2. At 10:15 a.m. Air Horns will sound in the various buildings to denote the beginning of the Great Shakeout.
3. At 10:19 a.m. fire alarms will sound in the various buildings across campus denoting the beginning of the Life Safety Drill.
4. When fire alarms sound everyone should orderly evacuate the buildings (take your personal belongings with you for security purposes) and follow the directions of the Area Wardens who will be easily identified by the Orange Safety vests.
5. Evacuate to the designated locations for assembly and accounting for everyone in the area.
6. Remain in the assembly area until the "All Clear" is given by the respective Area Warden.
7. After the "All Clear" is given return to your work station or classroom.
